Supply Pick Ups

Medical Appointment

A routine care appointment is just for vaccines. If you have a medical issue, please schedule a medical appointment i.e., upper respiratory infection, diarrhea, lethargy, weight loss, etc. If you aren't sure, just ask prior to arriving.

Puppies need to be kept inside only until they have had two vaccines. Concrete /deck area at your home is fine. No high traffic areas for puppies even after two vaccines. No dog parks or off leash for dogs. Cats/kittens are NOT allowed outside.
